Rite of Baptism

Priest: What name have you chosen for your baby?

Parents: N.N.

Priest: Do you wish your child to be a member of the Christian Family?

Parents: We do.

Priest: You have asked to have your child baptised. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him/her in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him/her up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbour. Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?

Parents: We do.

Priest: Godparents, are you ready to help the parents of this child in their duty as Christian parents?

Godparents: We are.

Priest: N., the Christian community welcomes you with great joy. In its name I claim you for Christ our Saviour by the sign of the Cross. I now trace the cross on your forehead and invite your parents and godparents to do the same.

Gospel

A reading from the Gospel according to Mark (10:13-16)

Prayer of Exorcism.

Celebration of Baptism & Blessing of Water

Priest: Praise to you Almighty God and Father, for you created water to cleanse and give life.

All: Blessed be God.

Priest: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, the Father's only Son, for you offered yourself on the cross, that in the blood and water flowing from you side, and through your death and resurrection, the Church might be born.

All: Blessed be God.

Priest: Praise to you God the Holy Spirit for you anointed Christ at his baptism in the waters of the Jordan, so that we might all be baptised into you.

All: Blessed be God.

Priest: Come to us Lord, Father of all, and make holy this water which you have created, so that all who are baptised in it may be washed clean of sin and be born again to live as your children.

All: Hear us Lord.

Priest: Make this water holy, Lord, so that all who are baptised into Christ's death and resurrection may become more perfectly like your Son.

All: Hear us Lord.

(The Priest touches the water with his hand.)

Priest: Lord, make holy this water which you have created so that all those whom you have chosen may be born again by the power of the Holy Spirit and may take their place among your holy people.

All: Hear us Lord.
