Laudato Si' is closely linked to three important social encyclicals that address workers dignity and rights, the threat of nuclear war, and the right of poorer nations and communities to development.

Pope Francis builds on these themes by taking a broader perspective, extending concern beyond workers and those living in poverty to embrace the whole of creation as our common home.

Laudato Si' reminds us that environmental degradation threatens the well-being of both present and future generations. Yet it is often the poorest communities, who have contributed least to environmental damage, that suffer its consequences most severely.

The encyclical challenges each of us to reflect on our patterns of consumption and waste, and to consider how we may be contributing to a culture of disposability and exclusion.
