The procession will proceed from the Wellington Monument to the Papal Cross.

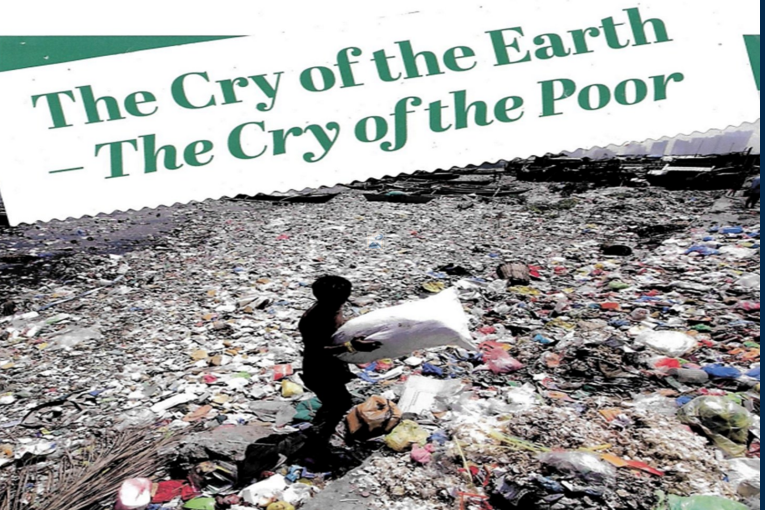
