The Bonnybrook Parish Pocket Forest Project is an exciting
 community initiative, and you are warmly invited to participate!

Details of the Event:

Thursday 12th September, 10:30am in room behind the church.

What's Happening: Leaders from Pocketforest Enterprise will be
 visiting to guide us on how to prepare the soil for planting and share
 the next steps in creating a small forest. This forest will consist of 70
 native trees along with a whitethorn hedgerow, which will be planted
 in an area behind the church. It's a wonderful opportunity to contrib-
 ute to enhancing our local environment and create a lasting green
 space for generations to come.

How You Can Help: We need around 20 volunteers to help with pre-
 paring the area for planting. Don't worry if you're not an expert -
 everything will be explained, and the Pocket Forest Team will provide
 all the necessary tools and equipment. Just be sure to bring some rain
 gear in case the weather turns!

After the Work: Once the work is done, you're invited to enjoy a
 warm cup of tea or coffee. It's a great way to relax, meet your fellow
