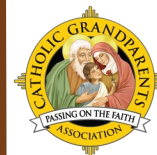

CELEBRATING THE WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY



World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated this Sunday 28th July—the Sunday closest to the Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, Grandparents of Jesus.

"Do not cast me off in my old age" (cf. psalm 71:9) is the theme chosen by the Holy Father for the forth Would Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. The National Grandparents Pilgrimage will take place in Knock and all are welcome. The principal celebrant Archbishop Luis Mariano Montemayor, Papal Nuncio of Ireland will lead the pilgrimage and music will be by the combined choirs of Knock Shrine, 'Lady of Knock' sung by Dana. All children are invited to write a prayer for their grandparents and send it to CGA Knock Shrine. Anointing of the Sick in the Basilica will take place at 2.30pm, the Pilgrimage Mass will take place at 3pm followed by the Rosary Procession.
