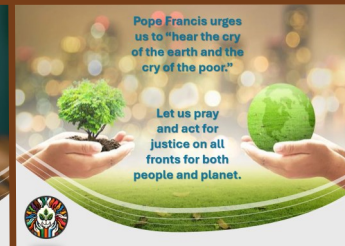

### PRATICAL ACTIONS DURING SEASON OF CREATION OUR SHARED FUTURE

The Global Environment Crisis is undeniable, and recognising this truth is essential to addressing one of the most critical challenges in human history. The few people who deny this are simply refusing to acknowledge reality. What is at stake is nothing less than our children's rights to a safe climate, clean water, breathable air, sufficient food and a planet rich in life. Environmental justice is vital because those least responsible for environmental damage often suffer its worst effects.

With today's scientific knowledge, we have the power to become the first generation capable of restoring ecosystems, fortifying infrastructure against storm surges and rising sea levels, and developing heat-resistant crops. Whilst this is undeniably a moment of crisis, it is also a moment of opportunity. We have the power to take bold action to safeguard our planet and shape a sustainable future.

The Season of Creation concludes on October 4th, but our efforts to build a safe and sustainable future for all must go on. Let us continue to pray **THE PRAYER OF CREATION**, drawing strength in our commitment to live more simply, so that all people and all creation may flourish.
